Condensation

Condensation build-up like this inhibits customer vision of the product, creates extra work for our client having to wipe the door, and will eventually start puddling within the case or on the floor, causing slip and fall hazard.



Frost & Ice

This freezer door was frozen shut after extreme humidity. Humidity creates condensation. The freezer system fights back by dropping the temperature. The coil is iced over, the box temperature rises, products spoil, and energy is wasted.



Health Code Violation

Pooling water is a health department violation that can give way to mildew and mold. What's more, temperature fluctuations as a result of humidity can ruin product integrity. Violations can follow if customers find frost-ridden freezer products, milk that has gone sour, thawed meat that has been refrozen, or ice cream gone soft.



Energy Efficiency

If cold storage equipment is not serviced, it can quickly fall out of energy efficiency—increasing operating costs. We recommend installing a device that turns on when the dew point increases rather than equipment that is energy efficient all of the time.
